**Posting of the Adopted Budget:** House Bill 3 from the 81st Session of the Texas Legislature requires school districts, on final approval of the budget by the board of trustees, to post a copy of the budget on the district's Web site. This requirement is in addition to posting the proposed budget. The Web site must prominently display the electronic link to the adopted budget. The adopted budget must be maintained on the Web site for three years after adoption. Tex. Educ. Code § 39.084.

**New Expenditure Code (Object 6491) for all statutorily required public notices**

**During the 85th Legislative Session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill (SB) 622. SB 622  
requires school districts to reflect in their proposed budget a line item specifically for**

**expenditures to publish all statutorily required public notices in the newspaper by the school district or their representatives. The line item must provide a clear comparison of the budgeted expenditures and the actual expenditures for the same purpose in the prior year, as required under Texas Local Government Code §140.0045.**
